You must complete at least one activity every two weeks during the Autumn term and these must be brought into school. You can choose how you present these activities.

Choose a country or person involved in WW2 and create a fact file.	Find a nut free recipe from WW2 and make it.	Design a poster about the dangers of electricity.
Design and make an Anderson Shelter.	Draw or find a map of Europe and colour the allied countries in green and the axis in red.	Create your own code and write a coded message.
Write a postcard home in the role of an evacuee.	Create a timeline of key events in WW2.	Design a propaganda poster.
Write a poem about the war.	<b>100 BOOK CHALLENGE</b> Read one book from the list.	Identify sources of electricity in and around your home.
