<p>Children should continue to practise their times tables and related division facts each week.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">e.g. $7 \times 3 = 21$ $21 \div 3 = 7$</p> <p>Remember to use Times Table Rockstars at home if you have internet access!</p>	<p>Children are encouraged to read every night and this should be recorded in their reading diary.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Roughly 15 minutes per night.)</p>	<p>A spelling pattern will be taught and tested in school each week. Spellings will be sent home and tested every Friday.</p>

Produce a fact file/ presentation to show your friends.</p>	<p>Draw yourself as a Victorian – you can be any type of Victorian you like (royalty, poorhouse child, rich factory owner, maid).</p>

Design your own model of a Victorian bathing machine or beach hut.</p>	<p>Draw a detailed picture of a Victorian school room. Or Make a small model of a Victorian School room.</p>	<p>Draw a portrait of Queen Victoria. Can you find out any facts about Queen Victoria?</p>	<p>Watch the film Oliver. Draw your favourite scene and write down at least 5 things you learn about the Victorians from this film.</p>
<p>The Victorians were very interested in developing manned flight. Make your own flying machines and test them. Record how far they flew and grade their gracefulness out of ten.</p>	<p>Read a story by Charles Dickens!
