Please ensure that lunch bags and boxes are clearly labelled to avoid any confusion for children with identical ones. May I remind you that fizzy drinks are not allowed as part of a packed lunch.

PE Kit Reminder

Please ensure that your child has a PE kit in school. We recommend that these remain in school and are taken home periodically to be cleaned and returned to school. Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name.
